RE: Dec. 2009 Drug Test Statistics and Year-End Data (Adult Arrestees)

Drug testing of adult arrestees for December 2009 revealed an increase in the level of substance abuse detected for PCP, which was up 1% from November to 10%. Amphetamines remained the same at 1%, while opiates and cocaine decreased 1% and 2%, to 8% and 25%, respectively.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 632 of the 1,673 screened, or 38% -- the same as the previous month.

The breakdown of December 2009 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP	--	160 (10% of those tested, 25% of all positive)
Total positive for Opiates	--	137 (8% of those tested, 22% of all positive)
Total positive for Cocaine	--	424 (25% of those tested, 67% of all positive)
Total positive for Amphetamines	--	12 (1% of those tested, 2% of all positive)


You may be interested in noting changes that have occurred in the detection levels of the drugs tested – cocaine, amphetamines, opiates and PCP – over the past several years. Therefore, we have attached a table that includes year-end data for the time period 1995 through 2009. **The overall percentage of adult arrestees testing positive declined from 44% in 2008 to 40% in 2009. This appears to be attributable primarily to a decline in the percentage of cocaine positives.**
