 RE: December 2011 Drug Test Statistics (Adult Arrestees)

Drug testing of adult arrestees for December 2011 revealed a 2% increase in the overall positive test rate (up from 31% to 33%) from November 2011. Multi-positives and opiates revealed a 1% decrease; PCP revealed a 1% increase; cocaine and amphetamines remained consistent with November 2011.

The breakdown of December 2011 test results is as follows:
