RE: June 2010 Juvenile Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees (both lockup and community cases) for June 2010 revealed an increase in the level of marijuana use.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 162 respondents prior to their initial hearing in June. Of the 151 lockup cases, 97 (60%) tested positive. Of the 11 community cases, 6 (55%) tested positive. The combined positive rate was 60%, up 6% from the previous month.


