January 2014 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

Juvenile drug testing for January 2014 (both lockup and community cases) revealed a 3% decrease in the level of marijuana use.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 111 respondents prior to their appearance in January. Of the 97 lockup cases, 36 (37%) tested positive for marijuana. Of the 14 community cases, 7 (50%) tested positive for marijuana. The combined positive rate was 39%, down 3% from the previous month.

January 2014 Synthetic Cannabinoids Testing

During the month of January, 28 of 78 samples were positive (35.9%) for synthetic cannabinoids. All were positive for the UR-144 metabolite, 6 were positive for the XLR-11 metabolite, and 3 were positive for the 5-Fluoro PB-22 metabolite.
