July 2013 Adult Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of adult arrestees for July 2013 revealed the overall positive test rate remained consistent with last month. Cocaine levels revealed a 1% percent decrease. Multi-drug positives and opiates levels revealed a 1% percent increase. Amphetamines and PCP positive levels remained consistent with last month.

July 2013 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

Juvenile drug testing for July 2013 (both lockup and community cases) revealed a 1% increase in the levels of marijuana use. Cocaine, PCP, and multi-drug positive levels remained consistent with last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 136 respondents prior to their appearance in July. Of the 136 lockup cases, 50 (40%) tested positive. Of the 12 community cases, 3 (25%) tested positive for marijuana. The combined positive rate was 39%, up 1% from the previous month.
