





MEMORANDUM

RE: January 2012 Juvenile Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees (both lockup and community cases) for January 2012 revealed an increase in the level of marijuana use. Multi-positives and PCP revealed 1% and 2% decrease respectively; cocaine and amphetamines remained consistent with last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 107 respondents prior to their initial hearing in January. Of the 96 lockup cases, 52 (54%) tested positive. Of the 11 community cases, 3 (27%) tested positive for marijuana and one of those was also positive for PCP. The combined positive rate was 51%, up from the previous month.
