





## MEMORANDUM

RE: June 2011 Juvenile Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees (both lockup and community cases) for June 2011 revealed an increase in cocaine and marijuana use and a decrease in PCP use. Amphetamines and multi-positives remained consistent with last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 168 respondents prior to their initial hearing in June. Of the 152 lockup cases, 78 (51%) tested positive. Of the 16 community cases, 8 (50%) tested positive for marijuana (but no other drug). The combined positive rate was 51%, up from the previous month.


