## MEMORANDUM

RE: April 2006 Drug Test Statistics (Adult Arrestees)

Drug testing of adult arrestees for April 2006 revealed an increase in the level of substance abuse detected for PCP, which was up 1% from March, to 10%. The levels of substance abuse detected for cocaine and opiates remained the same as the previous month, at 39% and 8%, respectively.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 871 of the 1,833 screened, or 48% -- up 2% from the previous month.

The breakdown of April 2006 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP -- 186 (10% of those tested,  
21% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 145 (8% of those tested,  
17% of all positive)

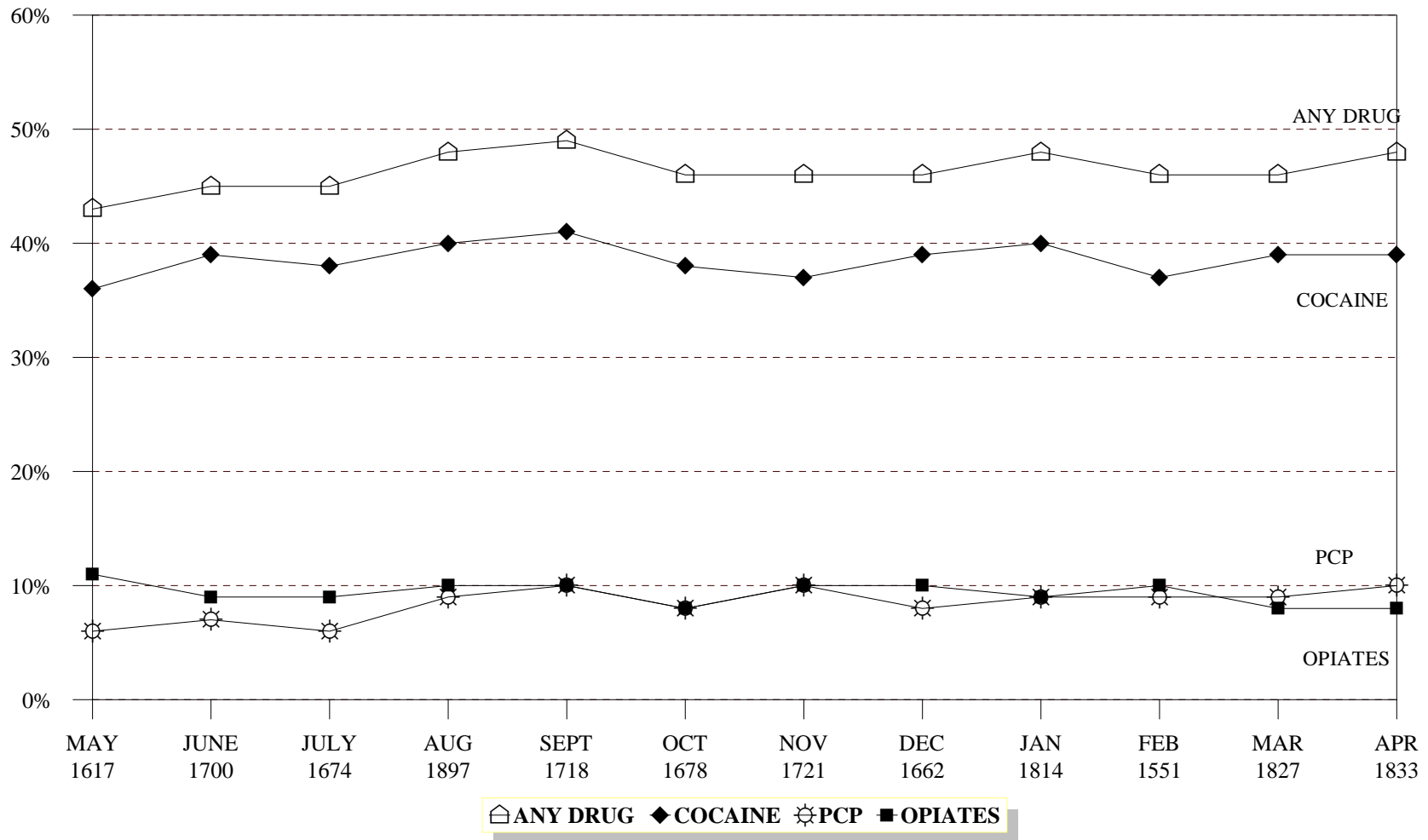
Total positive for Cocaine -- 716 (39% of those tested,  
82% of all positive)
