RE: Drug Test Statistics of Adult Arrestees (June 2005)

Drug testing of adult arrestees for June 2005 revealed an increase in the levels of substance abuse detected for cocaine and PCP, which were up 3% and 1% from May, to 39% and 7%, respectively. The level of substance abuse detected for opiates was down by 2% from the previous month, at 9%.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 766 of the 1,700 screened, or 45% -- up 2% from the previous month.

The breakdown of June 2005 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP -- 111 (7% of those tested,
14% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 160 (9% of those tested,
21% of all positive)

Total positive for Cocaine -- 654 (39% of those tested,
85% of all positive)
