RE: March 2004 Drug Test Statistics – Adult Arrestees

Drug testing of adult arrestees for March 2004 revealed an increase in the level of substance abuse detected for cocaine, which was up 1% from February, to 38%. The levels of substance abuse detected for PCP and opiates decreased 1% each from the previous month to 8% and 9%, respectively.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 849 of the 1,853 screened, or 46% -- up 1% from the previous month.

The breakdown of March 2004 test results is as follows:

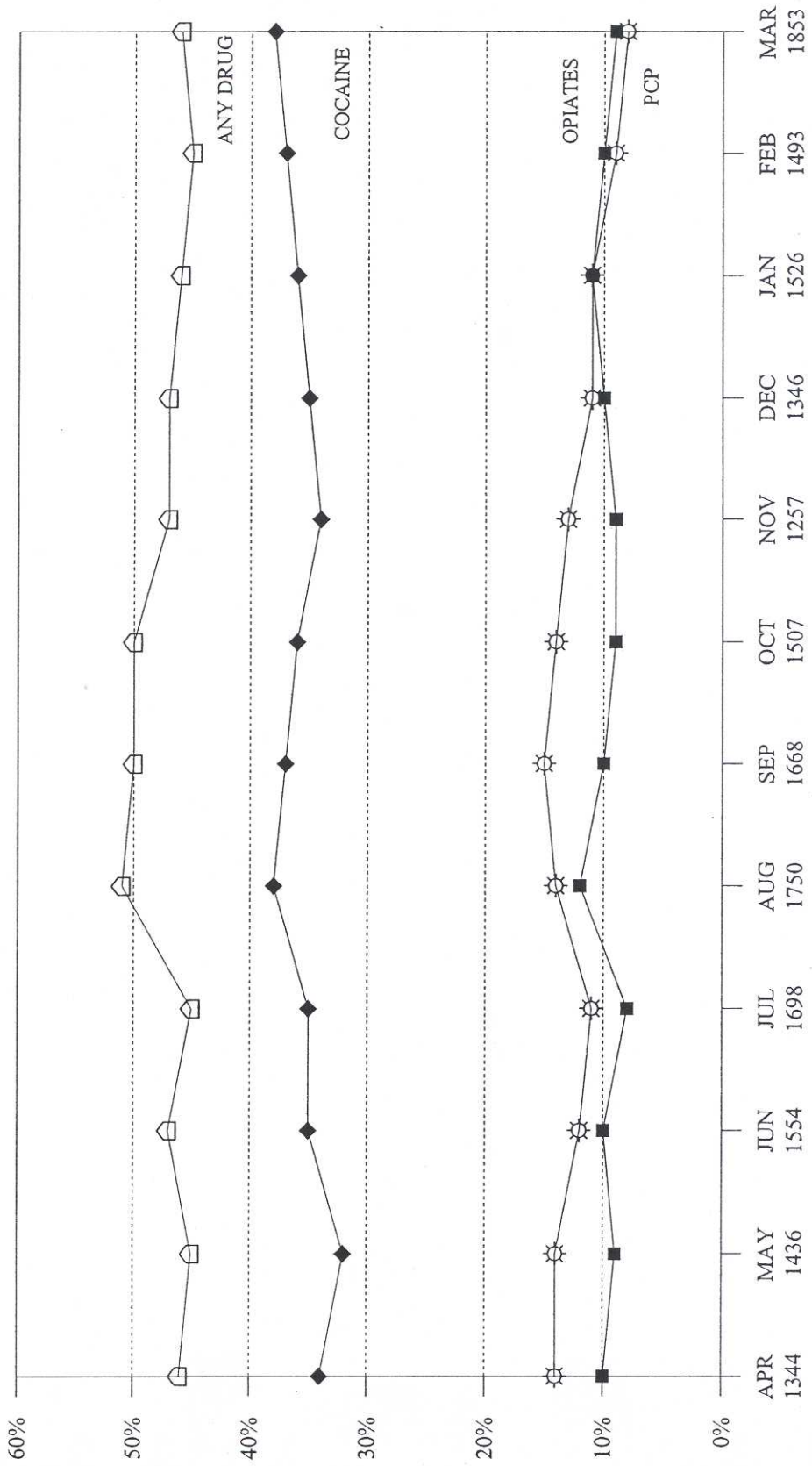
Total positive for PCP -- 150 (8% of those tested,  
18% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 173 (9% of those tested,  
20% of all positive)

Total positive for Cocaine -- 700 (38% of those tested,  
82% of all positive)
