RE: May 2004 Drug Test Statistics – Adult Arrestees

Drug testing of adult arrestees for May 2004 revealed an increase in the level of substance abuse detected for cocaine, which was up 5% from April, to 38%. The level of substance abuse detected for PCP decreased 4% from the previous month to 3%, while opiates remained the same at 10%.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 837 of the 1,942 screened, or 43% -- up 2% from the previous month.

The breakdown of May 2004 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP -- 64 (3% of those tested,
8% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 200 (10% of those tested,
24% of all positive)

Total positive for Cocaine -- 732 (38% of those tested,
87% of all positive)
