RE: Drug Test Statistics of Adult Arrestees (May 2005)

Drug testing of adult arrestees for May 2005 revealed an increase in the level of substance abuse detected for opiates, which were up 3% from April, to 11%. The levels of substance abuse detected for cocaine and PCP were down from the previous month by 1% each, at 36% and 6%, respectively.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 695 of the 1,617 screened, or 43% -- down 1% from the previous month.

The breakdown of May 2005 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP -- 104 (6% of those tested, 15% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 177 (11% of those tested, 25% of all positive)

Total positive for Cocaine -- 580 (36% of those tested, 83% of all positive)
