RE: <u>May 2007 Drug Test Statistics (Adult Arrestees)</u>

Drug testing of adult arrestees for May 2007 revealed an increase in the level of substance abuse detected for opiates, which were up 2% from April, to 10%. The levels of substance abuse detected for cocaine and amphetamines decreased 1% each from the previous month, to 38% and 3%, respectively, while PCP remained the same at 10%.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 1,074 of the 2,198 screened, or 49% -- down 2% from the previous month.


The breakdown of May 2007 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP		217 (10% of those tested, 20% of all positive)
Total positive for Opiates		217 (10% of those tested, 20% of all positive)
Total positive for Cocaine		842 (38% of those tested, 78% of all positive)
Total positive for Amphetamines 74 (3% of those tested, 7% of all positive)
