RE: Drug Test Statistics - Adult Arrestees [October 2006]

Drug testing of adult arrestees for October 2006 revealed a decrease in the levels of substance abuse detected for cocaine and opiates, which were down 1% each from September, to 40% and 8%, respectively. The level of substance abuse detected for amphetamines increased 1% from the previous month to 3%, while PCP remained the same at 10%.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 1040 of the 2,082 screened, or 50% -- down 1% from the previous month.

The breakdown of October 2006 test results is as follows:

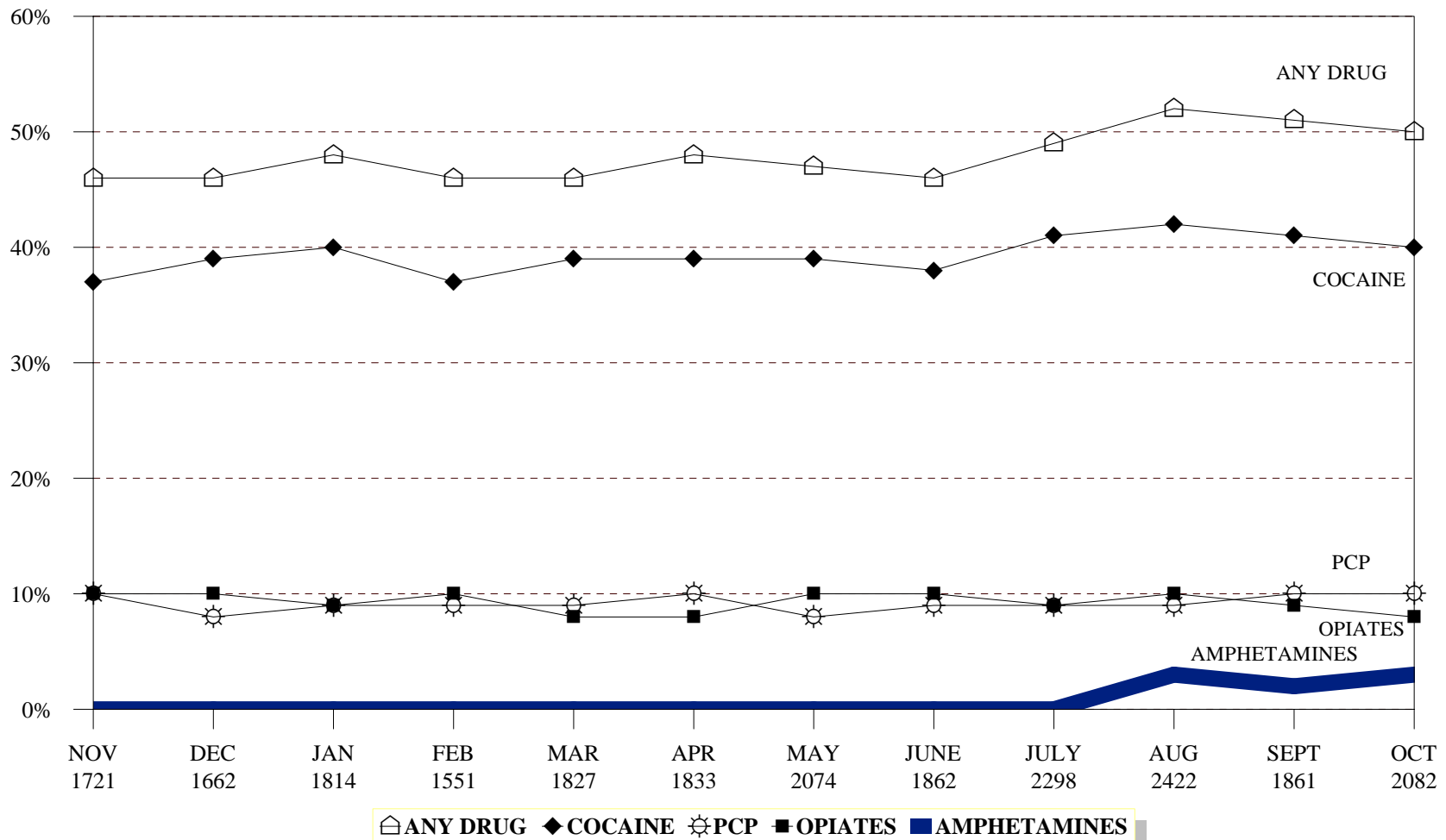
Total positive for PCP	--	212 (10% of those tested, 20% of all positive)
Total positive for Opiates	--	157 (8% of those tested, 15% of all positive)
Total positive for Cocaine	--	834 (40% of those tested, 80% of all positive)
Total positive for Amphetamines	--	70 (3% of those tested, 7% of all positive)
