RE: <u>Drug Test Statistics of Adult Arrestees (Sept. 2005)</u>

Drug testing of adult arrestees for September 2005 revealed an increase in the levels of substance abuse detected for cocaine and PCP, which were up 1% each from August, to 41% and 10%, respectively. The level of substance abuse detected for opiates remained the same, at 10%.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 836 of the 1,718 screened, or 49% -- up 1% from the previous month.

The breakdown of September 2005 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP -- 165 (10% of those tested, 20% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 175 (10% of those tested, 21% of all positive)

Total positive for Cocaine -- 698 (41% of those tested, 83% of all positive)
