RE: September 2007 Drug Test Statistics (Adult Arrestees)

Drug testing of adult arrestees for September 2007 revealed a decrease in the level of substance abuse detected for PCP, which was down 1% from August, to 8%. The levels of substance abuse detected for opiates and cocaine remained the same as the previous month at 10% and 37%, respectively; amphetamines increased 1%, to 4%.

The overall number of adult arrestees testing positive for at least one drug was 887 of the 1,885 screened, or 47% -- the same as the previous month.

The breakdown of September 2007 test results is as follows:

Total positive for PCP -- 150 (8% of those tested,

17% of all positive)

Total positive for Opiates -- 195 (10% of those tested,

22% of all positive)

Total positive for Cocaine -- 705 (37% of those tested,

79% of all positive)


Total positive for Amphetamines -- 76 (4% of those tested,

9% of all positive)









The D.C. Pretrial Services Agency resumed reporting on amphetamines in August 2006.
