Drug testing of adult arrestees for April 2016 remained the same as the previous month in the overall positive test rate. PCP use decreased by 2% compared to last month.

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for April 2016 (both lockup and community cases) decreased by 1% when compared to last month.
