February 2013 Adult Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of adult arrestees for February 2013 remained consistent with last month with an overall positive test rate of 27%. Cocaine levels revealed a 1% percent increase. Multi-drug positives and PCP levels revealed a 2% percent increase. Opiates and amphetamines levels remained consistent with last month.

February 2013 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

Drug testing of juveniles (both lockup and community cases) for February 2013 revealed a 6% increase in the level of marijuana use. Multi-drug positives, PCP, amphetamines and cocaine levels remained consistent with last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 137 respondents prior to their appearance in February. Of the 124 lockup cases, 63 (51%) tested positive. Of the 13 community cases, 5 (38%) tested positive for marijuana. The combined positive rate was 50%, up from the previous month.
