January 2013 Adult Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of adult arrestees for January 2013 remained consistent with last month with an overall positive test rate of 27%. Cocaine levels revealed a 1% percent decrease. Multi-drug positives, PCP, opiates and amphetamines levels remained consistent with last month.

January 2013 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

Drug testing of juveniles (both lockup and community cases) for January 2013 revealed a 5% increase in the level of marijuana use and decreases of 2% in multi-drug positives and PCP use, respectively from December 2012. Amphetamines and cocaine levels remained consistent with last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 120 respondents prior to their appearance in January. Of the 104 lockup cases, 46 (44%) tested positive. Of the 16 community cases, 7 (44%) tested positive for marijuana. The combined positive rate was 44%, up from the previous month.
