Drug testing of adult arrestees for January 2015 remained the same compared to last month in the overall positive test rate. PCP was down by 4% compared to last month.

# **January 2015 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics**

Juvenile drug testing for January 2015 (both lockup and community cases) was up by 2% in the overall positive test rate compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 130 respondents prior to their appearance in January. Of the 127 lockup cases, 47 (37%) tested positive for marijuana. Of the 3 community cases, 2 (67%) tested positive for marijuana.

### January 2015 Synthetic Cannabinoid Testing

During the month of January 2015, 117 specimens were tested for synthetic cannabinoids; 32 (27%) of these specimens tested positive. Of these, 25 (21%) tested positive for UR-144 metabolite. Also, 15 (12.8%) were positive for AB Pinaca metabolite. There were 2 (1.7%) samples in which 5-Fluoro PB-22 metabolite was detected and 2 (1.7%) samples in which XLR-11 metabolite was detected. There were also 2 (1.7%) samples in which AM2201 metabolite was detected. Samples were obtained from the pretrial, parole/probation and juvenile populations. The samples have been preselected by staff or the court for testing due to suspected use by the contributor.
