Drug testing of adult arrestees for July 2016 increased by 2% compared to the previous month in the overall positive test rate. PCP use increased by 1% compared to last month.

July 2016 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for July 2016 (both lockup and community cases) decreased by 14% compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 73 respondents prior to their appearance in July 2016. Of the 66 lockup cases, 24 (36%) tested positive for marijuana. Of the 7 community cases, 2 (29%) tested positive for marijuana.
