### Adult Drug Testing Statistics

Drug testing of adult arrestees for June 2013 revealed a 1% decrease in the overall positive test rate (down from 29% to 28%) from May 2013. All positive test levels remained consistent with last month.

Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

Drug testing of juveniles (both lockup and community cases) for June 2013 revealed a 1% increase in the level of marijuana use, a 1% decrease in PCP levels, and no cocaine use or multi-drug positives which remained consistent with last month.

PSA's Drug Testing and Compliance Unit tested 125 respondents prior to their court appearance in June. Of the 125 lockup cases, 41 (37%) tested positive. Of the 14 community cases, 6 (43%) tested positive for marijuana. The combined positive rate of 38% is consistent with last month.
