Drug testing of adult arrestees for June 2015 was down by 1% compared to last month in the overall positive test rate. PCP was up by 6% compared to last month.

May 2015 Synthetic Cannabinoid Testing

During the month of May 2015, 131 specimens were tested for synthetic cannabinoids; 67 (51%) of these specimens tested positive. Of these, 63 (48%) tested positive for the UR-144 metabolite. Also, 10 (7.6%) were positive for the AB Pinaca metabolite. There were 20 (15.2%) samples in which the 5-Fluoro PB-22 metabolite was detected and 1 (0.7%) sample in which the PB-22 metabolite was detected. There were 8 (6.1%) samples in which the XLR-11 metabolite was detected.

Samples were obtained from the pretrial, parole/probation, and juvenile populations. The samples have been preselected by staff or the court for testing due to suspected use by the contributor.

June 2015 Synthetic Cannabinoid Testing

During the month of June 2015, 80 specimens were tested for synthetic cannabinoids; 37 (46%) of these specimens tested positive. Of these, 34 (42.5%) tested positive for the UR-144 metabolite. Also, 9 (11.2%) were positive for the AB Pinaca metabolite. There were 22 (27.5%) samples in which the 5-Fluoro PB-22 metabolite was detected. There were 5 (6.2%) samples in which the XLR-11 metabolite was detected.

Samples were obtained from the pretrial, parole/probation, and juvenile populations. The samples have been preselected by staff or the court for testing due to suspected use by the contributor.
