Drug testing of adult arrestees for May 2015 was up by 3% compared to last month in the overall positive test rate. PCP was down by 1% compared to last month.

Juvenile drug testing for May 2015 (both lockup and community cases) was down by 18% in the overall positive test rate compared to last month.
