**November 2015 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics**

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for November 2015 (both lockup and community cases) increased by 5% when compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 89 respondents prior to their appearance in November. Of the 81 lockup cases, 37 (46%) tested positive for marijuana. Of the 8 community cases, 4 (50%) tested positive for marijuana.


