Drug testing of adult arrestees for November 2016 decreased by 1% in the overall positive test rate. PCP use decreased by 5% compared to last month.

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for November 2016 (both lockup and community cases) increased by 21% compared to last month.

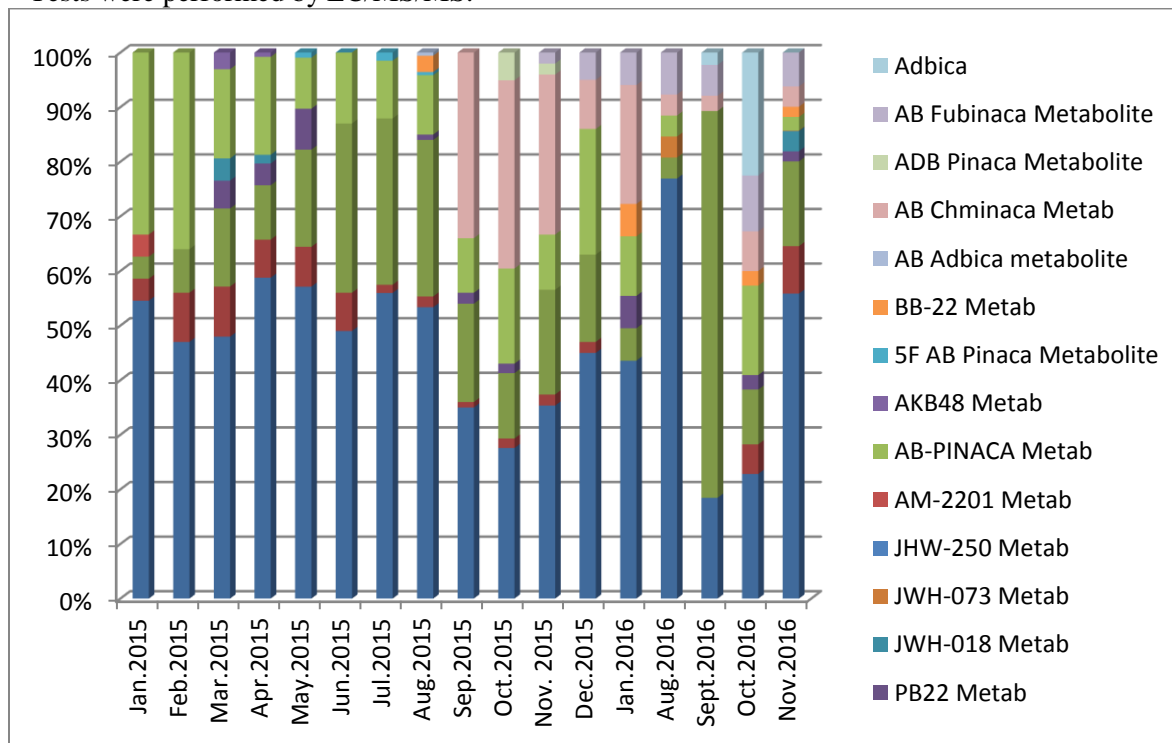
