Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics for July 2004

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees for July 2004 revealed a decrease in the level of substance abuse detected for PCP, which was down 3% from June, to 0%. The level of substance abuse detected for marijuana increased 3% from the previous month, to 52%, while cocaine remained the same at 2%.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 145 respondents prior to their initial hearing in July. Fifty-two percent (52%) of the 134 Lockup cases tested positive. Fifty-five percent (55%) of the 11 Community cases tested positive. The combined positive rate was 52%, up 3% from June.
