RE: May 2010 Juvenile Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees (both lockup and community cases) for May 2010 revealed a decrease in the level of marijuana use.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 209 respondents prior to their initial hearing in May. Of the 190 lockup cases, 108 (57%) tested positive. Of the 19 community cases, 5 (26%) tested positive. The combined positive rate was 54%, down 4% from the previous month.

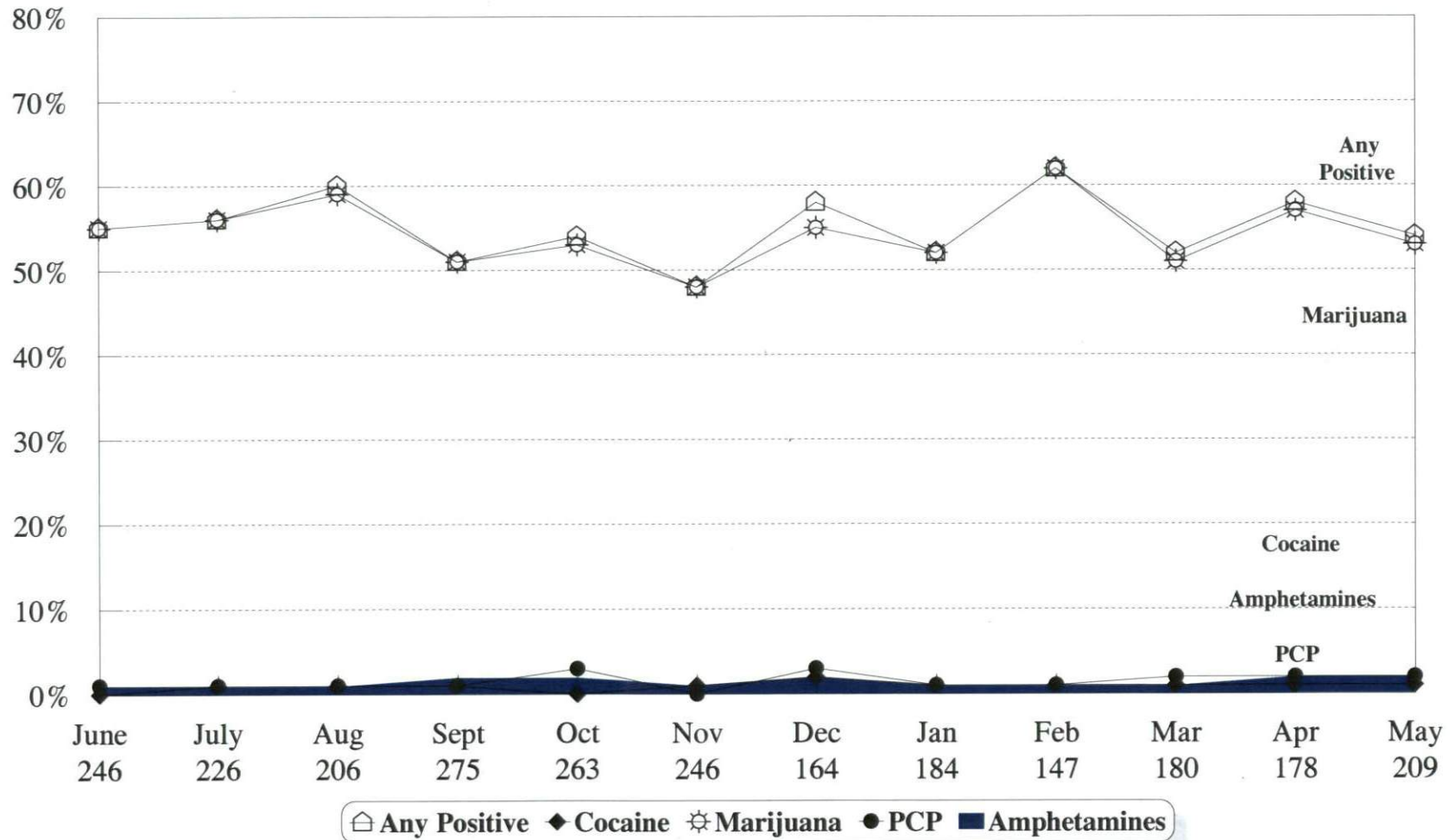
