May 2011 Juvenile Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees (both lockup and community cases) for May 2011 revealed a decrease in all levels of substance abuse categories with the exception of PCP, which revealed an increase, and amphetamines which remained consistent with last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 146 respondents prior to their initial hearing in May. Of the 134 lockup cases, 55 (41%) tested positive. Of the 12 community cases, 4 (33%) tested positive for marijuana (but no other drug). The combined positive rate was 40%, down from the previous month.


