RE: October 2007 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile arrestees for October 2007 revealed a decrease in the level of substance abuse detected for marijuana, which was down 2% from September, to 54%. The levels of substance abuse detected for PCP and cocaine increased 2% and 1% from the previous month to 4% and 3%, respectively, while amphetamines remained the same at 3%.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 183 respondents prior to their initial hearing in October. Fifty-five percent (55%) of the 162 Lockup cases tested positive. Forty-eight percent (48%) of the 21 Community cases tested positive. The combined positive rate was 54% -- down 3% from September.


