September 2010 Juvenile Drug Test Statistics

Drug testing of juvenile respondents (both lockup and community cases) for September 2010 revealed a decrease in the level of cocaine use and an increase in the level of marijuana and PCP use.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 224 respondents prior to their initial hearing in September. Of the 193 lockup cases, 109 (56%) tested positive. Of the 31 community cases, 18 (58 %) tested positive. The combined positive rate was 57%, up 5% from the previous month.


