SUBJECT: April 2018 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for April 2018 decreased by 4% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 27%. Multi-drug positives, opiates, PCP and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% decrease. Cocaine, amphetamines and heroin remained consistent.


