SUBJECT: August 2017 Drug Testing Statistics

Drug testing of adult arrestees for August 2017 remained consistent with last month, with an overall positive test rate of 29%. Multi-drug positives and cocaine levels revealed a 1% decrease. Synthetic cannabinoid levels revealed a 3% decrease. PCP levels increased by 3%. Opiates, amphetamines, and heroin levels remained consistent with last month.


