#### SUBJECT: August 2018 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for August 2018 remained consistent when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 28%. Cocaine revealed a 3% increase. Multi-drug positives, amphetamines and heroin each revealed a 1% increase. Opiates remained consistent. PCP and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% decrease.

## August 2018 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for August 2018 decreased by 6% when compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 56 respondents prior to their appearance in August 2018. Of the 56 lockup cases, 31 (55%) tested positive for marijuana. No community cases were tested for the month of August.


