**SUBJECT:** February 2018 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for February 2018 increased by 4% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 29%. Cocaine increased by 3%. Multi-drug positives and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% increase. Opiates, amphetamines, PCP and heroin remained consistent.


