Drug testing of adult arrestees for January 2017 decreased by 4% in the overall positive test rate. PCP use decreased by 3% compared to last month.

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for January 2017 (both lockup and community cases) decreased by 15% compared to last month.

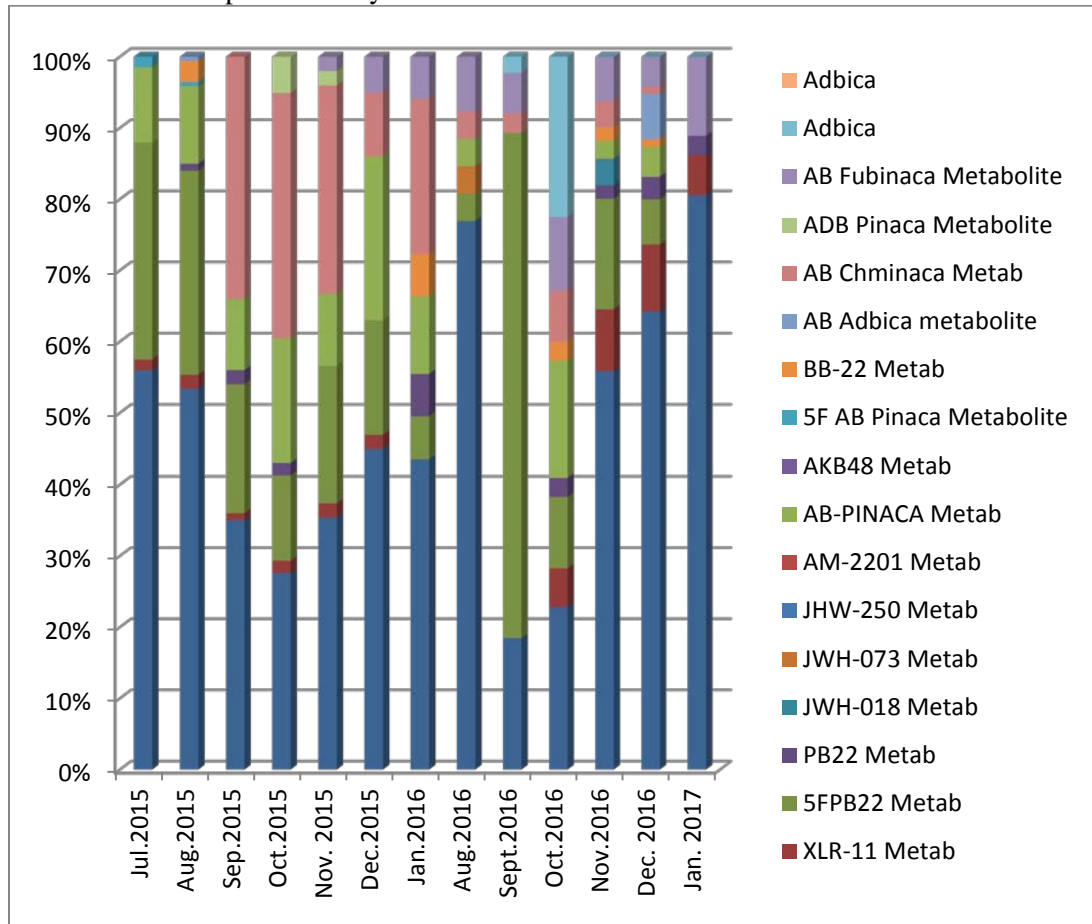
