**SUBJECT: July 2017 Drug Testing Statistics** 

Drug testing of adult arrestees for July 2017 increased by 1% when compared to last month. There was a 1% increase in multi-drug positives. Cocaine levels revealed a 1% percent decrease. Opiates, amphetamines, PCP, and heroin levels remained consistent with last month.


