SUBJECT: **July 2018 Drug Testing Statistics**

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for July 2018 increased by 1% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 28%. PCP revealed a 3% increase. Multi-drug positives, amphetamines and synthetic cannabinoids remained consistent. Cocaine revealed a 2% decrease, and Opiates and Heroin revealed a 1% decrease, respectively.

**July 2018 Juvenile Drug Testing Statistics**

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for July 2018 decreased by 5% when compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 59 respondents prior to their appearance in July 2018. Of the 59 lockup cases, 36 (61%) tested positive for marijuana. No community cases were tested for the month of July.

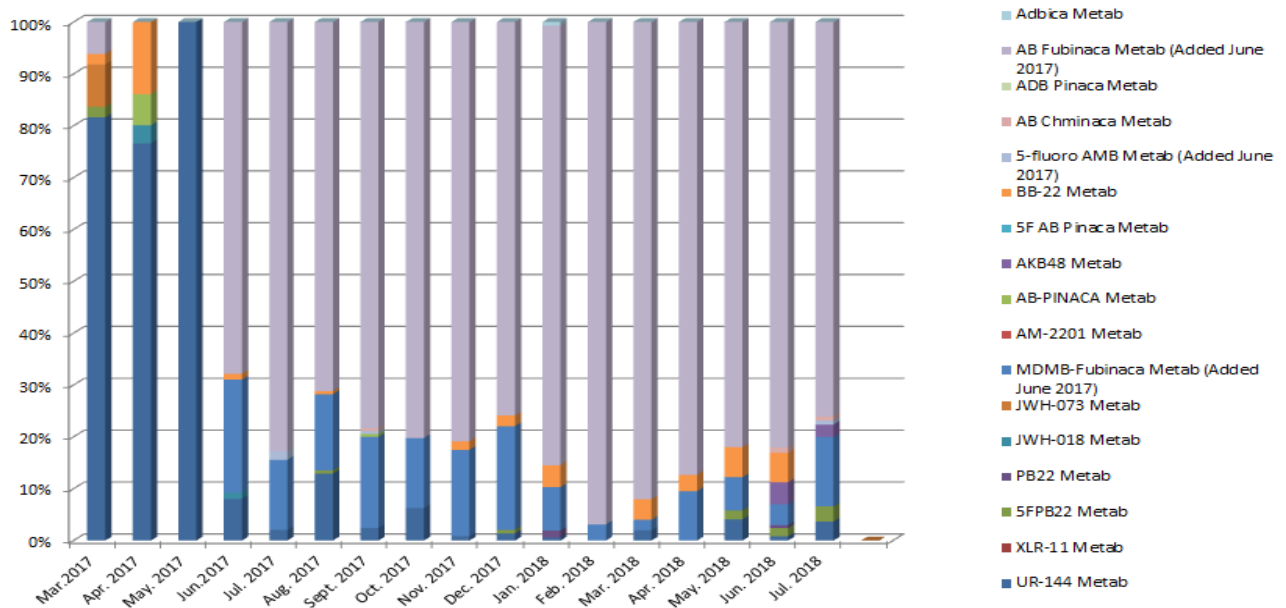
