**SUBJECT: July 2018 Drug Testing Statistics** 

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for July 2018 increased by 1% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 28%. PCP revealed a 3% increase. Multi-drug positives, amphetamines and synthetic cannabinoids remained consistent. Cocaine revealed a 2% decrease, and Opiates and Heroin revealed a 1% decrease, respectively.


