**SUBJECT: June 2018 Drug Testing Statistics** 

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for June 2018 decreased by 1% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 27%. Cocaine and opiates each revealed a 1% increase. Heroin and synthetic cannabinoids remained consistent. Multi-drug positives, amphetamines and PCP each revealed a 1% decrease.


