**SUBJECT:** November 2017 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for November 2017 decreased by 2% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 27%. Amphetamines, PCP and heroin remained consistent. Multidrug positives and cocaine each revealed a 3% decrease. Synthetic cannabinoids decreased by 2%, and opiates decreased by 1%.

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for November 2017 decreased by 13% when compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 74 respondents prior to their appearance in November 2017. Of the 74 lockup cases, 43 (58%) tested positive for marijuana. No community cases were tested for the months of October or November.


