**SUBJECT: October 2017 Drug Testing Statistics** 

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for October 2017 decreased by 2% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 29%. Multi-drug positives, cocaine and opiates each revealed a 1% increase. Amphetamines and PCP remained consistent. Heroin and synthetic cannabinoids decreased by 1%.

The positive rate for juvenile drug testing for October 2017 increased by 8% when compared to last month.

The Juvenile Drug Testing Unit tested 87 respondents prior to their appearance in October 2017. Of the 87 lockup cases, 61 (70%) tested positive for marijuana. No community cases were tested for the month of September.


