**SUBJECT: August 2019 Drug Testing Statistics** 

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for August 2019 decreased by 1% when compared to the previous month, with an overall positive test rate of 29%. Synthetic cannabinoids revealed a 3% increase. Multidrug positives revealed a 2% increase. Amphetamines revealed a 1% increase. Opiates, PCP and heroin each remained consistent. Cocaine revealed a 1% decrease.


