**SUBJECT: January 2020 Drug Testing Statistics** 

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for January 2020 increased by 3% when compared to the previous month, with an overall positive test rate of 29%. Amphetamines, PCP and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% increase. Multi-drug positives, cocaine, opiates and heroin each remained consistent.


