SUBJECT: July 2019 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for July 2019 increased by 2% when compared to the previous month, with an overall positive test rate of 30%. Opiates revealed a 2% increase. Multi-drug positives, cocaine, PCP, heroin and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% increase, respectively. Amphetamines revealed a 1% decrease.


