**SUBJECT: October 2019 Drug Testing Statistics** 

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for October 2019 remained consistent when compared to the previous month, with an overall positive test rate of 28%. PCP revealed a 2% increase. Opiates and heroin remained consistent. Multi-drug positives revealed a 3% decrease. Cocaine, amphetamines and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% decrease, respectively.


