SUBJECT: September 2019 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for September 2019 decreased by 1% when compared to the previous month, with an overall positive test rate of 28%. Cocaine and amphetamines each revealed a 1% increase. Multi-drug positives remained consistent. PCP revealed a 2% decrease. Opiates, heroin and synthetic cannabinoids each revealed a 1% decrease, respectively.


